### Foundation Scholarships

#### Patsy Jones Fee Memorial (for female students majoring in Agriculture)

Patsy Jones Fee (1929-1984) grew up on a ranch northwest of Fluvanna, Texas. She attended school at Fluvanna until the fuel rationing of World War II prevented the bus from coming to her ranch home. She later moved to Stephenville and finished high school at John Tarleton State School. She was one of the first women admitted into Texas Tech's College of Agriculture where she participated in Block and Bridle and also the meats judging team. She was later admitted to the School of Veterinary Medicine at Cornell. It is hoped that those who are helped by this scholarship in her memory will dedicate their lives to becoming a fine and hardworking person as she was.



#### Sam Joyce Memorial (for a sophomore student majoring in Agriculture/Range Management with a GPA of 3.0)

Sam Joyce (1915-1988) grew up working in cotton gins owned by his family in Scurry County. After graduating high school, he briefly attended John Tarleton College (later known as Tarleton State University). Sam had a passion for flying and took flying lessons in Sweetwater. He later served as a Final Inspector of Aircraft at Kelly Field during World War II. He was an original member of the Scurry County Airport Board and also served on the Planning and Zoning Board. He and his wife, Florentz Winston Joyce, had two children that he encouraged to obtain a higher education. His belief in higher education is the reason for the establishment of the Sam Joyce Memorial Scholarship.
