
Updated Covid CDC Recommendations

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Good Afternoon Everyone,

Well, the semester has begun and so has our exposure to Covid-19. WTC will be following the updated CDC recommendations below (also available at <https://www.cdc.gov/media/releases/2021/s1227-isolation-quarantine-guidance.html>)

If you have been exposed, or if you have tested positive, please check below for the current recommendations. Of course, please feel free to check with Brad Keller in HR if you have additional questions.

FYI - Our Doms open this Friday and all resident students must submit a negative Covid-19 test before moving in. In order to be valid, the negative test can not be dated earlier than 72 hours before move-in.

Reminder - Our In-Service Opening Session is tomorrow at 9:00 am in the Fine Arts Theater. See you there!

If You Test Positive (Isolate):

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

Stay home for 5 days.

- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- *If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.*

If You Were Exposed to someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine):

If You:

Have received a booster vaccination

OR

Have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

OR

Have completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.

If you:

Have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are **not** boosted

OR

Have completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are **not** boosted

OR

Are **unvaccinated**

- **Stay home for 5 days.** After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- If you can't quarantine you must wear a mask for 10 days.
- Test on day 5 if possible.
- *If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home*

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
