EDUCATIONAL TALENT SEARCH DRUG & ALCOHOL POLICY

No student shall possess, use, transmit, or attempt to possess, use, or transmit, or to be under the influence of any of the following substances on school premises during any school term or off-school premises at a school-related activity, function, or event:

- Any controlled substance or dangerous drug defined by law, without regard to amount, including but not limited to marijuana, any narcotic drug, hallucinogen, stimulant, depressant, amphetamine, barbiturate.
- Alcohol or any other alcoholic beverage.
- Any abusable glue, aerosol paint, or any other chemical substance for inhalation.
- Any other intoxicant, or mood-changing, mind-altering, or behavior-altering drugs prohibited under the Texas Controlled Substance Act or Federal Drug Abuse Prevention Control Act.

“USE” means a student has smoked, ingested, imbibed, inhaled, drunk, or otherwise taken internally a prohibited substance recently enough that it is detectable by the student’s physical appearance, actions, breath or speech.

“UNDER THE INFLUENCE” means a student’s faculties are so noticeably impaired that it is detectable by the student’s physical appearance, actions, breath or speech.

The transmittal, sale, or attempted sale of what is represented to be any of the above-listed substances is also prohibited under this rule.

STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO POSSESS ANY TYPE OF FIREARMS, EXPLOSIVES, OR WEAPONS AT ANY TIME.

STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE DISTRICT CODE OF CONDUCT.
