Edward Jones does have the authority to make investment decisions without prior approval as long as they comply with the investment policy.
2. Western Texas College does not utilize soft dollar, directed brokerage or directed commission, commission recapture, or similar arrangements.
3. Western Texas College is associated with WesternTexas College Foundation. The Western Texas College Foundation is managed by Jeremiah Boatright, Dean of College Advancement, 6200 College Avenue, Snyder Texas 79549. The fair market value of the foundation's investments equaled \$2,795,448 and are included above.
