

Golf Course and Campus Grounds Maintenance

Reports to: Superintendent of Golf Course and Campus Grounds

Hourly Wage: Based on experience, entry level is \$13.00/hr plus approved overtime

Essential Functions:

Assist in maintenance of golf course, soccer complex, baseball, softball, coliseum and campus grounds.

Equipment Operation:

Must be able to operate large and small equipment used in the maintenance of turf, trees and shrubs.

Examples are: Large reel mowers used for mowing fairways. Smaller reel mowers used for mowing tees, approaches, baseball, softball and soccer fields. Riding greens mower and walk behind greens mowers used for mowing putting greens. Deck mowers used for mowing golf course rough and campus grounds.

Must be able to operate small tractors attached to mowing equipment. Able to operate a front-end loader / backhoe a plus. Minor equipment such as rotary mowers, weed eaters, blowers, edgers, hedge clippers, vacuums and chain saws. Must be knowledgeable of using numerous hand tools.

Landscaping and Irrigation:

Must be able to assist in the installation of landscape plant material and sprinkler system installation.

Additional Duties:

Assisting in ice and snow removal from sidewalks and steps. Cleaning equipment as needed. Cleaning shop as needed. Applying fertilizers and pesticides as needed. Weekend work is required on an alternating schedule of every other weekend. Must work in weather conditions of extreme hot and extreme cold.

Actual Strength Requirement: Heavy to very heavy (must be capable of lifting 80lbs)
